"Where's the Minister?"

We were at Annual Conference one year when the bishop asked all the ministers in the auditorium to stand. Without hesitation those of us in the ordained ministry rose to our feet. The bishop smiled and said, "I think there has been a misunderstanding. I asked <u>all</u> the ministers to stand."

With the Bishop's added invitation, we felt a wave of understanding move across the room. Slowly, but still with some uncertainty, everyone stood.

The bishop provided a powerful visual of the difficulty we have in grasping what it means to be in ministry. It is a struggle that clergy and laity often share. For example, no pastors asked any lay people around them to stand following the bishop's invitation. Instead we somewhat smugly rose to our feet anticipating a pat on the back or a word of encouragement from the bishop. On the other hand, many lay persons hesitated to stand even after the bishop had clarified his invitation. They had reservations about standing with those they identified as the ministers.

A vital church does not rely solely on ordained clergy to do ministry. For a pastor to assume that he or she is the only one who can do ministry is an unhealthy approach to service in the church. Likewise, for the congregation to think that ministry can only be done by the pastors is just as unhealthy. For the body of Christ to be alive, vibrant, and healthy we need to consider and then accept our place in ministry.

St. Simons United Methodist Church has a tremendous staff team who help provide strong and meaningful ministries. We have incredible lay people who have offered their time and talents in service to the church and others. But to continue to move forward as a church and to grow in our individual discipleship we must remember that God has called all of us to serve.

I invite you to respond to God's call to serve in whatever ways you are needed. And the next time someone asks you, "Where's the minister" you will be able to answer, "I'm in ministry; how can I help?"

I look forward to being with you this Sunday as <u>all</u> the ministers gather to worship and we celebrate the ministry of the laity. We are one in the Spirit – we are one in the Lord – we are one in ministry together!


