I had some change in my hand. It was only a nickel and a dime. My daughter, Croft, who was three-years old at the time, asked me if she could have the coins. I was curious to see what would happen if I told her she could only have one. She chose the nickel. I asked her why she took the nickel. Her answer did not surprise me: "It was the biggest!" I explained to her that the dime was worth more, but that didn't matter. The nickel was larger; it had to be better.

Sometimes we overlook the value of small things. In Matthew 13, Jesus shares several brief parables about a mustard seed, yeast, treasure hidden in a field, and a pearl of great value. These parables teach us that the kingdom of heaven is often revealed to us in small and surprising ways, but that these small things can ultimately have a big influence on us and others.

Sometimes me may ask ourselves, "Have I done anything worthwhile lately?" If we go a step further and ask, "When is the last time I did something great that really made a difference" it can be easy to become discouraged.

Jesus encourages us to rephrase the question and ask ourselves, "What small things have I done lately?" Our small acts of kindness, caring, and love can lead to great things being accomplished. It's in sharing our simple gifts that others experience the tremendous value of God's presence in their lives.

We can become discouraged in our faith journeys because we are constantly trying to hit homeruns. Remember that Jesus says base hits are just as valuable. We are to persevere; to press on; to not worry so much about doing great things, but to give of our best in all things – even as small as those things may seem. To do so is to do your part to help others see God's kingdom here on earth as it is in heaven.

Make plans to join us for online worship this Sunday at 11:00am. The Reverend Benjy Varnell will be our guest preacher. Tune in anticipating a blessing! And remember that on August 2 we will return to in-person worship at 9:00am and 11:00am. We will also be live-streaming both services! We are making small steps towards even greater days in the life of our church!
