

Advent Sermon Series: "Christ is Born in Us"

As we continue our celebration of Thanksgiving weekend, we also transition into the first Sunday of the Christian Year – the first Sunday of Advent. Advent is a four-week season of preparation that leads us up to Christmas. During this time, I will preach a sermon series titled, "Christ is Born in Us." We are all experiencing a season in our lives where our doubts, frustrations, and anxiety have been pushed to the limits.
