

"The Journey"

How is your walk to Bethlehem going? Is the anticipation building as you get closer to Christmas? Are you growing spiritually? Or are you simply overwhelmed, feeling like the journey will never end or that it can't end soon enough?

When we consider the first journey to Bethlehem we are reminded that it wasn't easy for anyone. It certainly wasn't easy for Mary and Joseph.
