

#### "Our Invitation"

The words "comfort zone" are often used to describe the areas of our lives where we are most comfortable. Anything outside our comfort zone makes us – uncomfortable.

When Jesus invited his first disciples to follow him some of them were fishermen. It was their lifestyle and their livelihood to fish. But Jesus came along and told them to leave their nets, which for them was more than likely - uncomfortable. Still they followed. Not only did they follow, they followed immediately in response to Jesus' invitation.

As a second career pastor my invitation to full time ministry included the challenge to leave my nets. I wish I could say my response to follow was as immediate as the disciples. It wasn't. It was a struggle as the battle of my will was waged against God's call. I was fine where I was – good job, new home, able to choose where I lived, weekends off – this idea of leaving my nets was – uncomfortable.

What I learned, as possibly you have learned, is that God is persistent in his call. When the Holy Spirit tugs on your heart it can't be ignored. Soon, even though there were numerous uncertainties, I knew I had to accept God's invitation. I left my nets.

I have further learned over 30 years of ministry that God's invitation is not a one and done deal. God is constantly calling. He routinely challenges us to explore new ways to serve; to grow deeper in faith; and to be more like Jesus in our words and works.

My prayer is that we will respond obediently to God's direction in our personal lives and in the life of our church. Maybe you have struggled with your response to the new and creative ways God wants to use your gifts or lack of gifts. That's not unusual. But Jesus' invitation remains the same, "Follow me!" Will you accept?

Will you leave your nets, even if it makes you – uncomfortable?



## 2020 Annual Report

Your continued faithfulness has been a blessing on this year! Our church received \$1,056,924.25 in offerings and tithes for 2020. Our expenses for the year were \$1,090,037.35 and all apportionments and mission commitments were paid.

Expenses were under budget by \$81,647.65, but contributions fell short of the budget by \$114,760.75. We were fortunate to have received PPP Funds in the amount of \$ 118,013.43 which was forgiven in full by the SBA, leaving the church with \$84,996.15 for year-end. We added 23 new members in 2020 and ended the year with a total membership of 1065.

For 2021 there are 150 Pledges totaling \$722,970.00 and we started 2021 with \$65,426.01 in our operating checking account. Thank you again for your continued faithful stewardship to our church ministry! Your generous gifts allow us to share Christ's love and blessings locally and with the broader community.
