

"Priority Worship"

The Georgia Bulldog football team had its Red and Black Spring Game last Saturday.

The crowd was somewhat small especially compared to the attendance a few years ago. It was Kirby Smart's first year as head coach, and he challenged UGA fans to show up for the game. He said he wanted to see 93,000 people there And it happened! Georgia football fans heard and responded to the challenge. In the end, more than 93,000 came to the game – it was standing room only - to watch a practice game! Incredible!

It is interesting to see what draws a crowd. Crowds will support their favorite teams. Crowds will attend concerts. Crowds will flock to amusement parks. Whenever something takes a high priority in one's life, people want to be a part of the crowd.

Prior to COVID-19, attendance in worship services was already trending downward in churches across the country. Where there used to be crowds on Sundays, most sanctuaries had plenty of vacant seats. As more of us get vaccines and the guidelines in our communities become more relaxed, the question many pastors are asking regarding post-COVID is this: Will the people who were coming before come back now?

Pastors are aware that many of our parishioners have become comfortable with watching virtual worship. Attendance at inperson worship seems less necessary, less essential, and is certainly less convenient than ever before. I have heard it said, "Why should we dress and go to church if we can have church wherever we are whenever we want?" It's a fair question. I could easily get used to preaching from the comfort of my couch at home.

But what we need to remember is that we gather for worship because we are called to be the church together. God has given us each other; to grow together, serve together, and to build-up one another. When we shift our attention from being at church, to being the-church, it is easier to understand why it's important for us to be present.

I am grateful for your faithful worship attendance and support of the church both online and in-person during the pandemic. You have been amazing! It has been wonderful to see people return to worship in recent weeks as more of us become comfortable in doing so.

But at the same time, please understand that out of concern for everyone's well-being we will continue to practice our current social distance guidelines through at least August 1. For those of you who need to take precautions, please be safe, continue to stay connected, and take full advantage of joining us in virtual worship.

As we anticipate the day when the pandemic will be a thing of the past, I want to challenge you to begin to pray about making your worship attendance a priority once again. When you're here - when we're all able to be back together - the attendance is certain to be somewhat less than 93,000, but it will still be incredible!
