"One-Anothering"

Mrs. John B. Dodd first proposed the idea of Father's Day in 1909. Mrs. Dodd wanted a special day to honor her father, William Smart. He was widowed when his wife (Mrs. Dodd's mother) died in childbirth with their sixth child. Mr. Smart was left to raise the newborn and his other five children by himself on a rural farm in eastern Washington. It was after Mrs. Dodd became an adult that she realized the strength and selflessness her father had shown in raising his children as a single parent.

The first Father's Day was observed on June 19, 1910, in Spokane, Washington. At about the same time other communities across America were beginning to celebrate a "Father's Day." In 1924 President Calvin Coolidge supported the idea of a national Father's Day. It wasn't until 1966 that President Lyndon Johnson signed a presidential proclamation declaring the third Sunday of June as Father's Day.

Father's Day has become a day to not only honor our fathers, but all men who act as father figures. It gives us yet another opportunity to celebrate the gift of each other.

The Bible repeatedly refers to the concept of "one-anothering." We are instructed in the scriptures to love one another; to buildup one another; and to do to others what we would have them do to us. "One-anothering" also means to not take others for granted; to love others unconditionally; and to provide consistent guidance to those under our care. It is a way to help us be mindful that we are to put others above ourselves.

The practice of "one-anothering" provides a guideline for husbands, fathers, and for each of us in our relationships with others. On this Father's Day, I invite our men to dedicate yourselves to the practice of "one-anothering"; to being the best father, grandfather, uncle, brother, and friend you can possibly be. Take time to remember and reflect upon the love your Heavenly Father has shown you and commit yourself to giving God and others your best as one of his faithful followers.

This Sunday we complete the sermon series, "Life Lessons from a Pandemic." We will turn our attention to the gift of each other God has given us. Make plans to join us in-person or online as we worship together.
