The last thing my family wants to hear me say when we are in the car are the words, "I know a shortcut!" More often than not my shortcuts lead to dead ends, being lost, and adding time to the length of our trip.

I come by this naturally since my father was known to do the same thing. On one of his "shortcuts" my mother asked him, "Do you know where we are?" I will always remember his reply. "No, I don't know where we are, but we sure are making good time."
