

Thursday, February 24 - Harrington School



Celebrate Black History with a guided tour of the Historical Harrington School on SSI. Built in the 1920s, it served as the main educational structure for three African American communities on St. Simons Island. It hosted grades 1-7 until desegregation in the

1960s when students left to attend St. Simons Elementary. Dutch treat lunch will follow in Redfern. Bus leaves Thorpe Building at 10:00am and returns approximately at 2:00pm. Cost is \$5 and will be donated to the school for continued preservation. Reservations by February 17.



Tuesday, March 22 - Okefenokee Swamp



The church bus will leave the Thorpe Bldg. at 8:30am for Folkston Okefenokee entrance. Check out the visitor center and gift shop, Swamp Island Drive, Chessar Island Homestead/Boardwalk

and Owls Roost Tower. Look for wildlife and many bird and plant species. We will enjoy a 90 minute guided boat tour and Dutch treat lunch. If you have a National Park Senior Pass, please bring it.
