"Wake-Up Call"

When you check into a hotel the person at the front desk will often ask, "Would you like a wake-up call?" It's a service that is provided to help us rest more peacefully because we know that at the appointed we will receive the wake-up call we need.

The news we receive daily is troubling at best. Peace on earth? No way. Peace in our hearts? Not even close. There is a reason we so often feel anxious and uncertain. We find ourselves anticipating the next wave of bad news.
