

Thank You Notes

Thank you notes are important. From an early age my mother taught me that when I received a gift I should write a note. I confess that I would not always have my heart in it, but with the strong encouragement of my mother I would eventually get around to scribbling a few words of appreciation on a card.

Over the years I learned how important those notes were to the gift-giver, but also how important it was for me to express my gratitude. To this day I try to practice sending timely and heartfelt notes to those who blessed me with their kindness.

Paul wrote a thank you note to God and sent it to his friends called the Colossians. He told them he thanked God for their "faith in Christ Jesus," and for their love for each other, and for their Christian hope.

Following Paul's lead, I want to thank you for the vital role you play in our being the body of Christ at St. Simons UMC! Your faithfulness connects each of us closer to God; your love for each other makes us feel cared for; and the hope you share makes us feel good about the future, even in uncertain times. I thank God for you and that I have the privilege of being one of the pastors at such an incredible church. It is such a blessing to serve together in ministry with people who have a passion for loving and trusting God.

After Paul wrote his thank you note to the Colossians he encouraged them to write a note of their own, "giving thanks to the Father, who has enabled them to share in the inheritance of the saints in the light" (Colossians 1:12). Why don't you try it? Take time today to write a thank you note to God who is the source of our faith, hope and love, and who has included us as members of his Christian family. Make it a note that's from the heart. In expressing your gratitude, you will discover how blessed you are; and I feel certain that God, the greatest gift-giver of all, will appreciate it.

Following this Sunday's service, I will be on vacation for the next two weeks. I am grateful to have this time away. A special thank you to Rev. Richard Soper and Rev.
