# Roller Coaster Legacy

I have left a legacy! The torch has been passed. It happened while my family and I were on a visit to Sea World in Orlando last week.

I love roller coasters. My family has never shared my enthusiasm. Whenever I rode on a roller coaster I typically sat by a stranger because my wife and children would have none of

My eyes lit up as we approached Sea World! Almost everywhere I looked there were roller coasters. Within the first 15 minutes of our arrival. I got in line to ride the Manta, a coaster that passengers ride in a face down position. For me, and the stranger beside me, it was an amazing experience!

We soon walked by another roller coaster called Kraken. I asked my daughter Croft, "You wanna' ride?" There was some hesitation, but then to my surprise she said, "yes!" This would be her first time on a big roller coaster. She would be the first one of my children to ride with me. And for the first time I wouldn't have to sit by a stranger.

After a long wait that served to heighten the anticipation and anxiety, she did it! She rode Kraken! A coaster that climbs to 150 feet, turns its rider's upside down seven times, and reaches speeds of 65 mph! She loved it!

As for me, I thought I heard the angels calling me home. I experienced yet another of the growing reminders that I am not as young as I used to be. A ride that would have never phased me in the past felt like it was going to break me in two. It took me three days to get over the aches and pains created by my two minutes of euphoria.

I may never ride another roller coaster. If in fact it was my last ride, there was no better way to do it than with my daughter by my side. She was thrilled! She can't wait to get on the next ride! I was thrilled - the joy of riding roller coasters in the Jones family will live on in her!

My experience at Sea World is a somewhat silly example of an incredibly important truth – we hope that something of who we are will live on in others, especially in those we have had the greatest opportunity to influence. Have you taken time lately to consider what your legacy might be?

What about a legacy of being one who is faithful? Live each day "clothed with compassion, kindness, humility, meekness, and patience."

(Colossians 3:12). Use the daily opportunities you have to influence others for good. Invite them to join you in the ups and downs and twist and turns that make-up our journeys of faith. Encourage them; help them to overcome their fears; sit with

There is no greater legacy to leave than one who shared God's love. In doing so the joy of the journey will live on in you and in others!
