The Way Forward- FAQ on Disaffiliation

The current plan of our church is to hold off on a decision regarding disaffiliation from the United Methodist Church until after the General Conference meets in May 2024. As a means of helping to keep you informed we will use this space to provide routine updates on our church's way forward and answer frequently asked questions.

What happened at the called South Georgia Annual Conference session on Saturday, August 20?

62 churches were approved to disaffiliate from the South Georgia Conference and the United Methodist Church. Of local interest, The Chapel was one of the 62 churches. The Chapel was one of the largest membership churches in the Coastal District and was born out of our church. This makes a total of 80 churches to date in the South Georgia Conference that have chosen to disaffiliate. There are almost 500 churches that remain in the conference. 22 of the 26 largest membership churches are currently maintaining their affiliation with the UMC. These are churches that have 1000-3500 in membership and includes St. Simons UMC. These churches, like ours, will continue to go through the discernment process. Some have chosen to stay the course and wait for the outcome of the 2024 General Conference. Additional disaffiliation information is provided at sgaumc.org.
