

A Different Approach to Prayer

There is something I hope you will do the next time you pray. Consider the idea that prayer is not just doing but being. While the words of our prayers are important and the attributes of a disciplined prayer life are impressive, we should be mindful that prayer is an awareness of being in the presence of a power much greater than ourselves. This opens to door to what the apostle Paul referred to as praying without ceasing. He didn't mean for us to endlessly verbalize or do prayers. Praying without ceasing is an awareness of God's being present and our being in his presence at all times.

It is through this awareness of God with us that prayer has a certain quality of attention that comes upon us in any moment. We can busy doing something else, but when a person or any situation comes to mind, take it as a sign to pray.

I do my best to go on a daily walk. On those walks it is an excellent time to pray for members of our church and to pray for the church. Simply saying the person's name can be a prayer because often I don't know what that person needs, but I can be certain that God does. I am reminded that prayer is not so much about attempting to craft my words as it is to be aware of God's presence in that moment trusting that God has this under control – whatever this may be.

I will remind you throughout the year that our bishop has asked us and all United Methodists in the South Georgia Conference to share together in a year of prayer. Whenever our church, our conference, or our denomination comes to mind, breathe a prayer knowing God is with you in that moment and that he hears and knows the desire of our hearts.


