

Surprise

We are in the season of Easter on the Christian Calendar. Often referred to as Eastertide it includes the 50 days between Easter and the celebration of Pentecost.

If you were asked to define Easter in a word what would that word be? There are numerous words that come to mind but one that stands out to me is the word "surprise." Easter was without a doubt a surprise to many. But the surprises continued in the days following the resurrection. The disciples are surprised when Jesus appears in the room where they are gathered. 
Louis and Millie Gholson Scholarship
