He Did What?

When we look at the life of Jesus, we quickly discover out a lot of big things He did: miracles that brought Him fame, sermons that shook the culture of a region, and death itself that He defeated. It would've been easy for our Lord to revel in His acclaim. But He didn't. In fact, He often ran from it. It's odd to think that whenever Jesus did something that got Him too much attention, He left the area. He didn't stay and fight when the response was violent. He took off before they could crown Him king.

When you think about it, it's incredibly odd and almost counter-missional. But when we read in Philippians chapter 2, we find the reason: Christ was humble on earth because He knew what was being prepared in Heaven. We are then told to follow His example and "in humility value others above yourselves, not looking to your own interests but each of you to the interests of the others." (v. 3-4)

Rick Warren—Saddleback Church pastor and author of the Purpose Driven Life—wrote in the same book "Humility is not thinking less of yourself, it's thinking of yourself less." I wonder what our lives would look like if we reflected the humility of Jesus. He knew—and we know—the Power within. But He chose to be humble, to love, and to serve. It's this quality of humility that stands out as one of the most effective tools to reach our community with the Gospel, just like Jesus did.
