## A Part of My Story

Me? I would always be a part of her story? Wow! I was both awed and humbled in an instant. I appreciated the kind words but had never given much thought to my being a part of someone's story. Her words smacked me into the realization that how in any relationship, no matter the duration, we have the potential to have a lasting impact on a person's life.

How have you become a part of another person's story in this past week? Sometimes all it takes is a kind word, a friendly gesture, or a pat on the back - simple things we do or say that can be transformed into a memorable and meaningful impression on one's life.

All of us are a part of God's story. A story that is as old as creation, but as new as today. A story in which we are given daily opportunities to play a significant role in the lives of others. Make the choice to love others as Christ has loved us in doing so you will become a part of someone's story.
