

## Mother's Day

The idea for Mother's Day was first thought of by Ann Reese Jarvis. She believed such an observance would help reunite families which had been torn apart by the Civil War. She died, however, before her dream could be realized.

But her daughter, Anna, kept the dream alive. She too believed that a special day set aside to honor our mothers would strengthen the home and give needed exposure to the importance of family.

At her request, a special service was organized at Andrews Methodist Episcopal Church in Grafton, West Virginia. Anna donated hundreds of white carnations, her mother's favorite flower, for the service, which was held on May 10, 1908. On May 9, 1914, President Wilson proclaimed that the second Sunday in May would be observed as Mother's Day.

I am grateful for Anna's persistence and for what she did to help make this special day possible. My prayer is that this Mother's Day will be a time to focus on the ways we can strengthen our homes by putting Christ at the center of our households. Have a joyful Mother's Day as we celebrate God's wonderful gift of motherhood and the blessings of home and family.






