

It is a joy to welcome into each of our worship services this Sunday Bishop David Graves and his wife Nancy!

Bishop Graves serves as the episcopal leader of both the South Georgia Conference and the Alabama-West Florida Conference of The United Methodist Church. His passion is sharing Jesus, seeing the overlooked, joining God in transforming lives, and changing the world one person at a time.

Prior, he served as pastor of two Kingsport area churches, St. Matthew, and Mountain View United Methodist. He was on staff and was given his first appointment at Hixson United Methodist Church in the Chattanooga area where he served for 11 years.

Bishop Graves is a native of Knoxville, Tennessee, and graduated from the University of Tennessee, Knoxville, with a Bachelor of Science in Business Administration and Candler School of Theology, Emory University, Atlanta, Georgia, with a Master of Divinity.

He and Nancy have shared 40 years of marriage and have two children, Casey, and Gregg. Casey is married to her husband Bryan, and they reside in Kingsport with their son Brooks and daughter Lucy. Gregg is married to Tracy and is a proud stepfather to Hannah, they reside in Chattanooga.

The bishop's leadership and his hope for the future of the South Georgia Conference are much appreciated. His challenge to those of us in the local churches has been to focus less on departure and more on reaching new people with the gospel message. The people of St. Simons UMC accepted this challenge early on and have seen God at work among us in powerful ways.






