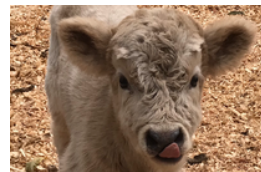
## Thursday, February 29 Darien Adventure

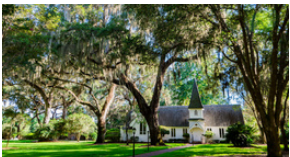
### Sunday, August 13 Amelia Island Players
