





Praying for Others

Prayer is communication that helps build our relationship with God. But like our personal faith journeys, most of us are at different places when it comes to our understanding and practice of prayer.

There are some who are prayer warriors. They have a sense of being constantly in God's presence and are quick to speak or breathe a prayer in any given moment. Others of us may be relatively new to prayer. We pray from time to time, but we are far removed from what one would consider an active prayer life. There are others who are confident in praying in public and have the ability to craft their words into beautiful and meaningful prayers. Then there are others who are afraid of being asked to pray in public and try to avoid it however they can.

But no matter how strong or weak our prayer lives may be, there have more than likely been times when we have wondered if prayer does much good. Is God really listening?

A man once pleaded for Jesus to heal his son. Jesus asks the man if he believes this can happen. The man responds, "Lord I believe. Help my unbelief." The man's statement is a declaration of faith as well as an admission that his faith is far from perfect.

The same can be said about our understanding of prayer. We are quick to confess our belief in the power of prayer while admitting that we have much to learn; that our prayer life is likely far from perfect.

This Sunday we will take a closer look at a prayer Jesus prayed; more specifically a prayer that he prayed for his disciples. In doing so he provides a model for intercessory prayer - prayers that we pray on behalf of other people. Why are some answered? Why are others seemingly not?
