





Whenever you see a treasure map, X typically marks the spot where the treasure is located. If you were fortunate enough to have a treasure map in your possession you would probably waste little time in beginning a search for the spot.

In our lives we often sense that there is "More" to the map of our life than what we are being shown. Who has the key to the treasure box of "More"? Where is the secret hidden? Where is the X on the map? People seem willing to look all over the place for this treasure. But the last place most people look for "More" is right under their feet, in the everyday activities, circumstances, and encounters of their lives.

The Reverend Barbara Brown Taylor writes, "No one longs for what he or she already has, and yet the accumulated insight of those wise about the spiritual life suggests that the reason so many of us cannot see the X that marks the spot is because we are standing on it. The treasure we seek requires no lengthy expedition, no expensive equipment, no superior aptitude or special company. All we lack is the willingness to imagine that we already have everything we need. The only thing missing is our consent to be where we are."

In the eyes of God, you are a treasure – whoever you are, whatever you have or don't have. When we commit our lives to serving him he promises us that our real treasure will be accumulated in heaven.

So, take a break from constantly looking for the next best thing. There's no need to be overwhelmed by the need for "More". Instead, take a moment to look down at the X beneath your feet. If you haven't discovered it yet, keep looking – it's there. It's there because God loves you. Accept that you are the best – a child of God – created in his image – that you are a real treasure.
