The Best Thanksgiving Day Ever

I have said it before, and I will say it again - Thanksgiving is one of my favorite holidays! Beyond the obvious warm feelings that come from our being grateful are the opportunities to be with family, enjoy some of our favorite foods, and to take a nap as we claim to be watching football on television. Best of all – no one expects any gifts!

Thanksgiving also provides us with special memories. At many of our tables there will be an empty chair or two. Take a moment to smile at those chairs and those who are not with us, trusting that they in turn are smiling back at you. Above all, Thanksgiving is a time to recall the words of an old hymn: "Count your blessings, name them one by one. And it will surprise you what the Lord has done"

I received an article this week written by Rev. Shane Bishop, the Senior Pastor of Christ Church in Fairview Heights, Illinois. He offers several suggestions to help us have the best Thanksgiving Day ever.

Make everyone stay at the table for a full thirty-minutes. Set a timer. No one leaves, except for seconds. No one. "Are you done eating? Who cares? Sit down." And not a bit of dessert or a sip of coffee for at least thirty-five minutes.

No phones at the table. None. If you look at your phone, it goes in the turkey carcass with the remaining stuffing. If your phone rings, you are doing dishes. No exceptions. Late violations can carry over to next year.

Say grace. Old fashioned. Heads bowed, eyes closed, holding hands. Have the patriarch or matriarch do it. Kids are cute. Let old people say grace. One person can keep their eyes open to monitor.

Tell your favorite Thanksgiving stories. The year of the huge Thanksgiving blizzard. The big family football game of 2012. The sweet potato casserole debacle of 2022. When the dog ate the turkey. Get out the old photos. The kind you don't have on your phone.

Laugh. A lot. Tell your funniest family stories. Make them better than last year. Don't talk politics!

Tell the people around your table just how much you love them and why they are special to you. There are no guarantees they will be here next Thanksgiving. Or you either, for that matter.

Help clean up and stick around. Clear the table. Watch some football. Take a nap. Go on a walk. Drink coffee. Eat a second piece of pie with your turkey sandwich. Drink more coffee.

Give thanks. Find a moment to get away, drop to your knees and personally tell God thank you.

My family and I are thankful for you and our amazing church. May this be for you, your family, and friends the best Thanksgiving Day ever!
