### **Community Holy Week Services**

### The Way Forward FAQ

If the United Methodist Church decides that homosexuals can be ordained, could we ever have a gay pastor appointed to our church? If The Book of Discipline were to change regarding the ordination of homosexuals there is a possibility that a gay pastor could one day be considered for an appointment in our church. But the appointment process has always had checks and balances in place regarding the pastor a church receives. Annual dialogue between the District Superintendent and the Staff-Parish Relations Committee provides an opportunity for input from the local church regarding its particular needs in a pastor. If the Staff Parish Relations Committee feels that a recommended appointment in our church is not an appropriate fit, the committee can ask to have the appointment reconsidered. But the possibility of our having a gay pastor appointed here is nothing but speculation and many years removed from our church, if ever. We are still under the current guidelines of The Book of Discipline which states that practicing homosexuals cannot be ordained. There is a good possibility this language will remain unchanged at this year's General Conference which will be held April 23 through May 3.


