## I Am the Resurrection

Jesus said, "I am the resurrection and the life." Jesus did not say "he was" or "he will be." Jesus said, "I am."

We can often get stuck between the "was" and the "will be" of what it means to experience the resurrection power of Jesus. For most of us there was a day when we accepted Christ and the promise of a new life. And now, through our belief in Christ we know there will be a day when our physical death becomes our passageway to eternal life.

What we often miss or fail to remember is that in two, simple words, "I am", Jesus gives us the assurance that he is with us every day. He offers us resurrection from difficult circumstances; he offers resurrection from dying relationships; he offers resurrection from broken dreams; and he offers us resurrection from lost hope.

The truth of Easter is not that we are to live newly only after death, but that we're to live newly in the moment. As a people of faith we claim this truth because of the transforming, life-giving, death-defeating power of the resurrection.

Today we remember and celebrate Jesus' victory over the grave and his promise of life. Because he lives, we also will live – today and for all eternity!
