Stand Out Christians

When we consider someone who is a "standout" we think of individuals who attract attention either for the way they look or behave, or because they perform better at something than other people do. Our immediate attention turns to actors, musicians, athletes, authors, those individuals who stand out in our minds as someone special in their areas of expertise.

Do you know any standout Christians? They are the ones who through their words and actions identify so closely to the examples of Christ that we are amazed at the depth of their faith. They are the individuals who have maybe made you think, "I could never be as good of a Christian as that person." But the truth of the gospel reminds us that we can! Each of us are the beneficiaries of the same grace and goodness of God. The call we share in common as a people of faith is that we are to stand

out. Over the next five weeks I will be preaching a sermon series

entitled, "Stand Out Christians." We will look closely at the qualities and characteristics of a standout Christian. The series is mostly based on the book of Ephesians, but includes a small dose of 1 Kings mixed in for good measure:

Romans 12:2 challenges us with these words: "And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, so that you may prove what the will of God is, that which is good and acceptable and perfect"

One of the greatest compliments you can be paid as a child of God is that you are different. The renewing of your mind puts you on a path that stands out from the world around you. And people notice. I look forward to sharing these sermons with you as we learn together how to better and more consistently stand out as we live into our faith.




