

God's Dress Code

Every Sunday in our church there are those who choose to wear casual clothes. The fact that our church is in a beach community has an influence on the way we dress not only for church but for almost any occasion on the island. One of the reasons I love our church so much is the casual, laid-back atmosphere that is a part of our identity; an attitude that makes it acceptable for the pastors, choir, and acolytes to dress casually between June and October before we return to our more formal attire in November.

I grew up in a day when every Saturday night my mother would make me take a bath - whether I needed it or not. I had to shine my shoes - whether they needed it or not. I had to lay out my Sunday clothes before going to bed — because apparently my mother was under the impression that all the dresser drawers and closets magically locked on Sunday morning.

All of this was in preparation for me to be dressed on time and looking my best when I went to church. Getting ready for church on Saturday night became a ritual in our household. I feel certain that if my mother were here today and saw that I was actually leading worship and preaching while wearing casual clothes she would wonder, "Where did I go wrong?"

I don't mind dressing-up. I know it's true that some of us are more comfortable dressing in our Sunday best all the time — that's perfectly okay if that's what you choose to do. But it is also okay if you choose to be comfortably and casually dressed for worship, because when we cut through it all, do we really believe God is that interested in what we wear to church? Do we believe that God has a dress code?

This week we continue the sermon series, "Stand Out Christians." We will be reminded of what God wants us to wear – the whole armor of God; that if we are to comply with God's dress code, what is most important is that we put on the Lord Jesus Christ. What is fashionable in our church is that you are here and that the desire of your heart is to grow more in love with Jesus through our offerings of worship. "Just as I am...O Lamb of God, I

come, I come."


- First time guests please fill out the yellow, "Welcome Card" located in your pew. Please drop in the offering plate or bring to the Welcome Desk to receive a gift!
