





## **Weekly Bible Reading Highlights**

What did you highlight in your Bible June 16-22? A few of the verses that stood out for Tom are:

2 Chronicles 24:20 – Then the Spirit of God came upon Zechariah. He stood before the people and said, "This is what God says: Why do you disobey the Lord's commands and keep yourself from prospering? You have abandoned the Lord, and now he has abandoned you!"

Jonah 1:1 – The Lord gave this message to Jonah: "Get up and go to the great city of Ninevah. Announce my judgment against it because I have seen how wicked its people are."

Jonah 1:17 – Now the Lord had arranged for a great fish to swallow Jonah. And Jonah was inside the fish for three days and three nights.

Jonah 3:4-5 – On the day Jonah entered the city, he shouted to the crowds: "Forty days from now Ninevah will be destroyed!" The people of Ninevah believed God's message, and from the greatest to the least, they declared a fast and put on burlap to show their sorrow.

Jonah 3:10 – When God saw what they had done and how they put a stop to their evil ways, he changed his mind and did not carry out the destruction he had threatened.

Amos 5:15 – Hate evil and love what is good; turn your courts into true halls of justice. Perhaps even yet the Lord God of Heaven's Armies will have mercy on the remnant of his people.
