A Beautiful Tree

The opening chapter in Psalms begins with a simple, but powerful image – a tree. But this tree is not just any tree. This tree is a well-watered, strong, thriving tree that can take a little heat or survive a drought. It's got roots. It's got fruit. It's got great leaves.

The psalm gives us two life paths: one rooted in God's ways, the other wandering off with bad advice, bad company, and – eventually - bad consequences. The person who delights in God's word is like that strong, steady tree. Not flashy. Not always noticed. But growing, bearing fruit in season, and staying green through the ups and downs of life.

So, what's the secret? It's in the daily rhythm of our faith journey. Not sprinting from spiritual high to spiritual high, but just quietly soaking in God's guidance, like roots soaking up water. We are not required to be "fruitful" all the time - Psalm 1 even says the tree yields in season. There's grace in that. Growth takes time. Fruit takes patience. Leaves sometimes get droopy. But stay planted, and God does the rest.

I challenge you and our church to be like a tree planted by the water. Stay rooted in the good news of Jesus Christ. Avoid shortcuts. And don't worry if you're not seeing fruit yet - it's coming. In the meantime, stay watered, stay connected...you will continue to be a beautiful tree!

I look forward to seeing you this Sunday at 8:30 am and 10:30 am. Let's plant ourselves in worship - ready to grow!


