TODAYS MESSAGE Growing Good People Micah 6:1-8

6 Listen to what the Lord is saying: "Stand up and state your case against me. Let the mountains and hills be called to witness your complaints. And now, O mountains, listen to the Lord's complaint! He has a case against his people. He will bring charges against Israel. "O my people, what have I done to you? What have I done to make you tired of me? Answer me! For I brought you out of Egypt and redeemed you from slavery. I sent Moses, Aaron, and Miriam to help you. Don't you remember, my people, how King Balak of Moab tried to have you cursed and how Balaam son of Beor blessed you instead? And remember your journey from Acacia Grove^[a] to Gilgal, when I, the Lord, did everything I could to teach you about my faithfulness." What can we bring to the Lord? Should we bring him burnt offerings? Should we bow before God Most High with offerings of yearling calves? Should we offer him thousands of rams and ten thousand rivers of olive oil?

Should we sacrifice our firstborn children to pay for our sins? ⁸ No, O people, the Lord has told you what is good, and this is what he requires of you: to do what is right, to love mercy, and to walk humbly with your God.

Walk Humbly with God

In 1980, country singer Mac Davis released a song that became an instant hit. Its lyrics went:

> "O Lord, it's hard to be humble When you're perfect in every way. I can't wait to look in the mirror 'Cause I get better lookin' each day. To know me is to love me— I must be a heck of a man. Oh Lord, it's hard to be humble, But I'm doin' the best that I can!"

With its tongue-in-cheek humor, the song made many of us smile. But beneath the satire lies a deeper truth - humility doesn't come naturally. It's not always easy to embrace, especially in a culture that prizes success, competition, and the urge to stay one step ahead of others.

We're taught to climb higher, achieve more, and prove ourselves. But humility? That has to be learned as well, and it's best developed as we grow closer to God.

In the book of Micah, the people ask the prophet what they should do to please God. They thought God would want extravagant offerings and impressive displays of devotion. But Micah's answer cuts through all of that with surprising simplicity. God isn't looking for over-the-top religiosity. He's looking for our hearts.

Micah 6:8 offers a clear and powerful summary of what God desires: "What does the Lord require of you but to do justice, to love mercy, and to walk humbly with your God?"

To walk humbly with God is to live dependently, reverently, and faithfully. It means letting go of status and ego and instead choosing daily surrender and trust. When we walk humbly, justice and mercy aren't forced - they flow naturally from our lives.

This week, may Micah's words invite us to pause and reflect: **Am I walking humbly with God?**

Am I seeking justice and showing mercy in my daily life?

Let us be a church that lives out these ancient yet ever-relevant truths - not just in our words, but in the way we live.


