He had numerous close finishes, but never could seem to play well enough to win. He had played in 163 PGA events without winning! His entire career had looked like an exercise in futility. However, that all changed last Sunday, as he actually won his first PGA tournament! He sure picked a good one to win! It was the Tour Championship, the highest money event of the year, which paid him a prize of 10 million dollars! You couldn't help but be happy for him!

After his victory, he made this remarkable statement, "I've been a PGA Tour winner for a long time, it's just always been in my mind!" I love that attitude!
