





Let His Light Shine Through

One morning at a former church I entered my office, and my heart sank. There appeared to be a stain on the recently installed, brand new carpet.

Those who know me know that I have a tendency to spill things - especially coffee. My first thought was that I had done it again. In hurrying through the office, I had unknowingly spilled coffee and created this ugly problem.

I walked slowly toward the discolored carpet. I had to take a closer look but was almost afraid to do so. I began to rehearse in my head what I would say to the Trustees about the stain in the hope they would be understanding. Then lightly, cautiously, I rubbed my foot over the spot; maybe it was just dust or something else that could be easily removed.

I was shocked as the top of my shoe changed to the color of the stain! I felt relieved as I realized that the "stain" was actually the light of the sun shining though the multi-color glass window in my office. Somehow the light was shining through in such a way that it picked up only one color from the glass. If there had been multi-colors on the floor I probably would not have given it a second thought; I had seen that before. But the one color made me stop in my tracks!

There are times when we become complacent in our faith journeys. We choose to blend into the "multi-colors" of light produced by the church to do things, that while attractive, become a part of the routine. While attending to the routine is helpful and much needed, let's remember how God wants to shine through each of us individually.

The work of the church is a powerful attraction and does much good for the kingdom. But remember the power that is in you to help change lives for good. God may shine through you in unusual or unexpected ways – but it may be the thing that stops someone in their tracks and helps that person see in you a reflection of God's love and grace.
