





A Heart of Gratitude and Generosity

What I will always remember about a mission trip to an orphanage in Honduras was the joy of the children. Though they had little to call their own, they radiated gratitude. A smile, a hug, or a heartfelt "thank you" was given freely - even for the simplest of gifts. Their joy was not rooted in possessions, but in a spirit of gratitude.

For many of us, the word "stewardship" can feel heavy - especially when we're working hard to make ends meet. But the first step toward generous living isn't about the size of our bank account; it's about the condition of our heart. Gratitude changes everything. When we learn to focus on what we have instead of what we lack, worry begins to give way to joy, and joy naturally overflows into generosity.

Paul reminds us in Philippians 4:11–13: "For I have learned to be content with whatever I have. I know what it is to have little, and I know what it is to have plenty. In any and all circumstances I have learned the secret of being well-fed and of going hungry, of having plenty and of being in need. I can do all things through him who strengthens me."

That's the heart of stewardship. We don't give out of guilt, obligation, or fear. We give out of gratitude - thankful for God's love, thankful for God's provision, thankful for the privilege of being part of Christ's work in the world. Joyful and generous giving is simply one more way we glorify God.

Weekly Bible Reading Highlights

What did you highlight in your Bible September 14-20? These are a few verses that stood out to Tom:

Esther 4:14 - "If you keep quiet at a time like this, deliverance and relief for the Jews will arise from some other place, but you and your relatives will die. Who knows if perhaps you were made queen for just such a time as this?"

Esther 9:22 - Mordecai told them to celebrate these days with feasting and gladness and by giving gifts of food to each other and presents to the poor. This would commemorate a time when the Jews gained relief from their enemies, when their sorrow was turned into gladness and their mourning into joy.

Esther 9:28 - This Festival of Purim would never cease to be celebrated among the Jews, nor would the memory of what happened ever die out among their descendants.

Nehemiah 2:17 - But now I said to them, "You know very well what trouble we are in. Jerusalem lies in ruins, and its gates have been destroyed by fire. Let us rebuild the wall of Jerusalem and end this disgrace!"

Nehemiah 6:15-16 - So on October 2 the wall was finished - just fifty-two days after we had begun. When our enemies and the surrounding nations heard about it, they were frightened and humiliated. They realized this work had been done with the help of our God.




