





What's Next?

United Methodists love meetings and nearly every meeting comes with an agenda. Over the years of my ministry, I've created more agendas than I can count. Most of them ended with the same question: "What's next?" In other words, where do we go from here?

Last Sunday in the worship services I announced that I will be retiring on December 31, 2025. As I approach my 70th birthday in January, I've been reflecting on life, health, and family. I want to be fully present for my wife and daughter, and to do so I've realized that I can no longer give the 100% that this wonderful church deserves. The time has come to begin a new chapter for me and for our congregation.

The question on my mind and possibly yours is, "What's next?" We enter a season of transition - one that involves both the church and the Jones family. Transition can bring uncertainty, but it's also a time for growth and trust.

What's next? I invite you to join me in praying for our church and for each other in the weeks ahead. Ask God:

- To help us release any anxieties from the past and about the future.
- To help us begin this new chapter with a clean heart and open
- To give us wisdom and courage to adapt to new situations with a positive attitude, seeing God's hand at work in every change.
- To commit our paths to God, trusting that he will guide us even when the way forward seems unclear.
- To remind us that God is our refuge and strength; that he will neither fail nor abandon us.


