Follow His Star

On January 6th, we observed what is known as Epiphany or the arrival of the Wise Men to see the Christ child. These Magi, as they are sometimes called, were men who studied the stars to foretell major world events. They had seen the star of Jesus visible to them in the East, probably Persia, close to 1000 miles away. Then they set out on a great journey to follow the star wherever it took them. After maybe 2 or 3 months, they arrived in Jerusalem trying to find this newborn king. They told the evil king Herod they had come to worship the baby. Herod told them to go and find the babe so he could worship him too, although his intent was not to worship him but instead to have him killed.

The Wise Men found the young Jesus in a house in Bethlehem as the star directed them, and they indeed worshipped him. Bowing down to a baby, they presented him gifts fit for a king, those being gold, frankincense and myrrh. Then, being warned not to return to Herod's palace, they went home by an alternate route.

I have always marveled at the complete, unwavering focus of these three kings. They committed themselves to following the star of Bethlehem until they finally found the One they sought, Christ the Lord! The word epiphany means a great revelation, and in Jesus they found the greatest revelation of all! They were not deterred by vast distance nor distracted by a murderous ruler in reaching their goal. They were determined to find Jesus and they found him.

As we enter a New Year, I wonder how dedicated we are to finding Jesus. Do we want to worship the One who came to save us all, or are we more interested in finding wealth, fame, power or whatever we think will make us happy? It's so easy to get caught up in what Jesus called "the cares of the world" and to lose sight of His Star which points us to love, grace, mercy and devotion. I pray we will dedicate ourselves to being not who the world is calling us to be, but to being who Christ is calling us to be! May that be our Epiphany!!
