## A New Plan

Are you a planner? Some people try to plan out everything in their lives, while others just take life as it comes. I'm kind of in between. I try to plan certain things but also realize that life is often unpredictable and events are sometimes unplanned. Scottish poet Robert Burns wrote in a poem "The best laid plans of mice and men, often go astray." That line reminds us that no matter the careful structure of our plans, they sometimes don't pan out.

Think about how often we get up in the morning with definite plans about what we're going to do or get done today, only to find that those plans have changed considerably by noon or earlier. The question then becomes what will we do when things don't go as planned. Will we get upset and become distraught that our plans didn't work or will we go to a new plan to deal with the unexpected? Some call this plan B, and sometimes we find ourselves going all the way through the alphabet to plan Z, depending on how many things have changed during the day. Such is life. It is never cut and dried, which can be very frustrating.

You often hear football coaches give interviews after games, and when asked how they were able to win, they all seem to go to one word. That word is "resilient." We were resilient! That word means being strong while also being flexible. The idea of resiliency is that we won't quit or panic when things don't go the way we planned. We will not be defeated by the ups and downs of life.

As we try each day to follow Jesus both in word and deed, we are often met with obstacles, trials, temptations and hard decisions. We ask ourselves am I doing the right thing; am I being who Jesus would want me to be; am I following Jesus or the world? These are good questions to ask and the way we answer them will shape our lives each day. We need to be flexible, but not stubborn. We also need to remain Christ centered and dedicated to following His teachings. We need to see that no matter how life might change, we are called to be faithful followers. To use the Bible word, we are to persevere. We are to trust and obey, realizing that God's will and way are better than any plan the world might create or promote. That may sound like an old plan, but in reality it is a plan that is always new, as God moves us ever onward and upward to His future!
